Section 7865 (B) Of the California Business and Professions Code states the following:
“Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent’s survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or part, by or on behalf of the decedent”.

BASIC PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

Basic services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our fee for the basic services of Funeral Director and Staff includes, but is not limited to:

- 24 hour availability of staff to respond to initial request for service
- Arrangement conference with family or responsible party
- Preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits
- Preparation and filing of death certificate
- Coordinating arrangements with cemetery, crematory and/or other parties involved with final disposition.
- Overhead expenses relative to our facility such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building, and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, bookkeeping, secretarial and administrative expenses. This is a non-declinable fee.

*This fee for our basic services and overhead will added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you selected. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials).

PREPARATION OF BODY CARE:

“Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.” A funeral establishment must refrigerate an un-embalmed body in its possession if burial or cremation does not take place within 24 hours. Keep in mind that embalming does not prevent decomposition of a body.”

USE OF FACILITIES AND STAFF:

Use of Facility and Staff for Visitation(4 Hours)

Includes use of all necessary facilities for visitation and private; Set-up of viewing room, placement of deceased, display of floral arrangements, staff for supervision and assistance during the viewing, including vigil and mass before funeral ceremony.

Use of Facility and Staff for Funeral Ceremony

Includes services of staff and clerical personnel, personnel to arrange and coordinate services; care of flowers and accompanying cares from donors; funeral service staff at church and place of interment.

Use of Equipment and Staff for Church Service

Includes service personnel for ushering care of flowers and accompanying cards from donors; arranging flowers, clergy record and delivering and arranging them at the interment location; committal service at cemetery.

Use of Facility and Staff for Memorial Service

Includes services of staff and clerical personnel, personnel to arrange and coordinate services; use of flower van; funeral service staff at church; clergy record, ushering, care of flowers and accompanying cards from donors; arranging flowers at the church.

Use of Equipment and Staff for Graveside/Niche side Ceremony

Includes services of staff and clerical personnel to arrange and coordinate services; funeral staff services; care of flowers and accompanying cards from donors; delivering and arranging flowers at the cemetery for interment.

Saturday / Sunday / Holidays

Due to of week-end personnel difficulties, there is an additional charge for a Funeral Ceremony or Graveside Service on Saturday. Most of Cemeteries are not hold on Sundays.

Home Service

Includes only for home doors that are 35 inches wide for casket to fit for visitation, staff to coordinate service at home, utility van.

SHIPPING SERVICES:

FORWARDING OF REMAINS

Standard forwarding of remains to another Funeral Home

Transportation to funeral establishment within 30 miles radius, Basic services and facilities.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS:

Standard receiving of remains from another Funeral Home

Basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, transportation of deceased from airport, touch up deceased hair, make-up, leakage, refilling of disposition permit at local health department. This fee does not include transportation to church or cemetery.

Visitation and receiving of human remains for Graveside Service

Includes Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff, transportation from local airport of 30 mile radius, burial permit, visitation, memorial book, funeral coach with driver, gloves, touch-ups for cosmetics, hairdressing and control any leakage.

MINIMUM SERVICES:

IMMEDIATE BURIALS: \$2500.00 to \$10,000.00

Disposition by burial without formal viewing, visitation, or ceremony with the body present includes transfer of remains to cemetery within 30 miles of our business, basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, refrigeration. Embalming is not required. Additional cost if authorized for minimal preparation.

Immediate burial with container provided from the purchaser
(All such containers must meet any applicable state and cemetery requirements.)

Immediate burial w//cloth covered casket from our facility

Direct burial with casket selected from our facility (In addition to cost of casket – see Casket Price List for casket prices.)

DIRECT CREMATION:

“If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering)”. The containers we provide are cloth-covered and/or unfinished wood boxes. A disposition of human remains by cremation without viewing/visitation, rites or ceremony.

INFANT / CHILD ARRANGEMENTS

Age 1 – 6 a discount of 50% will be applied to burial, cremation, receiving or forwarding of remains, whether itemized or packaged professional fees. This discount does not apply to merchandise (casket, register book/folders or prayer cards), cash advance items, additional mileage, motorcycle escorts, limousine use, weekend or holiday fees.

INFANT / CHILD ARRANGEMENTS (Continued)

Age 7 – 12 a discount of 40% will be applied to burial, cremation, receiving or forwarding of remains, whether itemized or packaged professional fees. This discount does not apply to merchandise (casket, register book/folders or prayer cards), cash advance items, additional mileage, motorcycle escorts, limousine use, weekend or holiday fees.
